

#### **Seniors Farmers' Market Nutrition Program**

- Booklet = 10 coupons worth \$2 each
- Can be used at WIC-approved certified markets
- Eligibility:
  - > At least 60 years of age
  - ➤ Low-income
  - ➤ Able to sign for the booklet (or send a proxy)
- Good for:
  - ➤ Fruits
  - ➤ Vegetables
  - ➤ Cut herbs
  - ➤ Honey

#### **Older Americans Act**

- Enacted in 1965
- Reauthorization required in 2011
- Title IIIC Funds congregate and home delivered meals
  - ➤ Each meal to provide 1/3 of daily nutrition requirement
  - > Fee cannot be charged
  - ➤ May request donation





#### **MOW/CM Qualifications**





- Homebound by reason of illness, disability, and/or isolation
- Have difficulty shopping and preparing meals
- Have a need for Case Management services



#### **Meals on Wheels Services**

- Delivers three meals a day/five days a week
- Donation based program
- Suggested donation is \$4.50 a day
- \$1.38 is our average daily donation
- Community SeniorServ serves 1,100 homebound seniors
- Wait List








#### **Increased Access to Supportive Services**

- Provides more resources to live independently



## **Sustained Increase in Well-Being**


- Well-being evaluated by program staff on defined factors

- Improved health and nutrition for frail seniors


